

## **ACEAFNE Report from the 2nd transnational meeting in Ostrava, Czech Republic**

The second transnational meeting of ACEAFNE took place in Ostrava from the 8th till 10th November 2016. Its aim was to evaluate the activities from the first year of the project, do the SWOT analysis of the project, discuss what is good and what can be improved and plan the work and activities for the second year.

There participated 23 teachers and head teachers from 7 states plus the teachers from organising school from Ostrava. There were 3 participants from Lithuania, Poland and Sweden, 2 from England, Italy, Romania and Portugal had 4 participants.

The first day started with welcome presentation showing to participants Ostrava and its region, then we continued with the tour of the school. After that, each state presented the best activities that they have performed during the first year of the project. In the afternoon, we visited the area called Dolní Vítkovice which is a great example of the sustainable development of the city. It is an old iron making factory which has been transformed into cultural centre. The old iron furnace can still be visited there but now, the area is used for cultural events, concerts, sport events etc.

On the second day all participants visited some classes, as most of the classes are taught in English, they can all understand and see the subject according to their choice. Later, the comparative study of questionnaires was presented. It compared the initial questionnaire for students and teachers that everybody filled in at the beginning of the project with the intermediary questionnaires that were filled in after the first year, we then discussed the results and made conclusions. In the afternoon we did the SWOT analysis of the project and discussed all possible problems. Later, we visited the townhall of Ostrava with view tower and guide explained to everyone mining history of the city and environmental problems that it is still facing.

On the third day, we planned the new activities, future meetings and intellectual output-guide of good activities. In the afternoon we visited Mining museum in Lanškrounská area that is nicely showing the mining history of Ostrava region and its environmental problems. It was established in the place of an old mine and it is also a good example of sustainable development.
